<u>Homemade Kinetic Sand</u>





This week let's make our own super squishy and moldable kinetic sand!

You will need:

- 1 cup play sand
- 1/2 tbsp corn starch
- 1 tsp dish soap
- 1 cup of water (added as needed)
- Optional: Food coloring

Instructions:

- 1. Begin by combining the play sand and corn starch in a large bin or container, and mix well.
- 2. In a second container combine water, dish soap, and food coloring (if desired). Stir until the water is bubbly.
- 3. Slowly add the water mixture to the sand mixture, a little bit at a time. Mix continuously as you add the water.
- 4. You will likely use between 3/4 cup and 1 cup of the water mixture, depending on whether your sand is more coarse or more fine. Continue to add the water until your desired consistency has been reached.
- 5. Add shovels, cookie cutters, or other kitchen gadgets, and kids will have a blast as they create and play!

Tips & Storage:

- 1. Store your homemade kinetic sand in an air-tight container between play times, and it can be used again and again.
- 2. If the sand dries out between play, mix a small amount of soapy water into the sand. This will restore it to the desired consistency.
